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## **Extracurricular Activities Participation Policy**

Our students are expected to excel in and outside of the classroom. While participation in a sport or club is required, North 13<sup>th</sup> Street Tech holds all students to high academic standards. We will; therefore, continue to enforce the grading policy for any student who participates in an extracurricular activity. This is not a means of punishing our students, but a measure taken to ensure each student reaches his/her maximum potential in preparation for college and the workforce.

#### STUDENTS MUST MAINTAIN A GRADE OF "C" OR HIGHER

#### Students with a "D" or "F" on a Progress Report:

All students are responsible for obtaining progress report grades from each teacher on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of each month. Students who show a grade of "D" or "F" in any subject:

- Must attend tutoring or enrichment classes from 3:05 p.m. to 4:05 p.m. and may not practice or participate in club activities until after 4:05 p.m.
- Cannot travel on a school bus to a game or practice before 4:05 p.m.
- <u>Cannot</u> "suit up" or play in any games until their grade(s) improve and they are re-evaluated by the club or athletic advisor 15 days after the progress report showing the "D" or "F"
- Must improve their grade within a 30-day period to remain a member of the team or club.

### Students with an "F" for a Cycle:

Any student, who receives an "F" for any cycle, may not fully participate in any sport or club until the middle of the next cycle. Sports players may not receive a uniform. These students must obtain a "C" or higher on their mid-cycle progress report in order to participate.
