
The students start training on a variety of bench operations: Filing, soldering, reaming and drilling. They are then given instruction in such services as front wheel alignment and brake lining. As they advance, they learn about power transmissions, engine repair, carburetion and the electrical system. Practice is provides for the examination and inspection of customers automobiles to determine the need and cost of repair.






As they advance, they learn about power transmissions, engine repair, carburetion and the electrical system. Practice is provides for the examination and inspection of customers automobiles to determine the need and cost of repair.








AUTO ENGINE SHOP


Instructor-Mr. Martorelli. In the Auto Engine Shop, related auto information, instrument measuring, layout drawing and writing are the first things a student will learn.

The students will learn how to diseassemble and assemble engines and engine accessories, complete engine rebuilding using machinery such as valve refacer, sear grinders, ring ridge removers set and measure bearings etc.

The student will learn how to check electrical and fuel systems with gauges and testers and be able to perform complete tune-up service.

Upon completion of the Auto Engine Shop course the student should be able to function as an auto engine apprentice.






BEAUTY CULTURE

Instructor- Mrs. Steele. The students are taught all branches of cosmetology in the field. They learn care of equipment, shop cleanliness, care and knowledge of skin, manicuring, hair waving, hair cutting, massage practice and sterilization. The students practice the skills weekly on patrons in the Beauty Culture Clinic. This course prepares students to take the state examination for licensure.







BEAUTY CULTURE

Instructor- Mrs. Campi- The course trains students to provide the services usually available to patrons of a beauty salon. Students are taught to cut hair, comb and wave hair, create new coiffures, give manicures, give hair, scalp and skin treatments and apply chemical relaxers, thermal curls, cosmetic lotions and creams. The students attend several hair show demonstrations to obtain a full range of new services and products available.









CARPENTRY

Instructor- Mr. Morlock. The purpose of this course is to train students to become competent in all phases of house building from rough framing, roofing, fine interior trim, sheetrocking, cabinet building and installation, and window and door fittings. Students are given thorough instruction in all technical phases of the carpenters job such as reading plans, making details from architects drawings, estimating, roof framing and stair building. They are also taught how to operate woodworking machinery used by the carpenter.













ELECTRICITY SHOP










GRAPHICS SHOP

Instructor- Mr. Scranton. The Purpose of this shop is to train students in the fundamental knowledge and skills involved in the printing field. The students are taught how to operate a variety of printing presses and how to make the necessary adjustments for smooth even printing. The operation of other print shop equipment, as well as processes involved in layout and computation of materials and costs are included in the instruction. The fundamentals of offset photography, plate making and offset printing are part of the training. Related instruction include study of color, the chemistry of inks and printers English.





MACHINE SHOP



Blueprint reading, bench work, machine set-up, precision inspection, maintenance and shop service are also included in this training. Instruction in heat treatment of metals, forging and finishing rounds out the students preparation for machine shop work.





MECHANICAL DRAFTING

Instructor- Mr. Russo. The shop is designed to give the students fundamental training essential to employment in the field of drafting. Students are given practice in the use of drafting tools in the preparation of drawings from which blueprints can be made. Detailed drawings are made to scale, with measurements and other markings included so that the accurate information can be conveyed. Sizes, shapes, and forms are projected from various viewpoints, in correct perspectives.


The students are instructed in the knowledge of materials, physical properties, and functions in the field in which they are working. In addition, they receive training in mathematics.





WELDING SHOP

Instructor- Mr. Logue. This shop includes the planning and layout of work from drawings, blueprints or written specifications. A knowledge of the welding properties of steel, for example: stainless steel, cast iron, bronze and aluminum is learned. Students must also determine the proper sequence of work operations for each job and learn to weld all types of joints in various positions (flat, vertical, horizontal and overhead). It is expected that the student will have sufficient knowledge of the trade to enable him/her to enter into satisfactory employment upon completion of the course and/or be able to begin apprenticeship training in preparation for more advanced phases of trade.

OFFICE TECHNOLOGY

The students are trained in general business courses that include clerical skills, business machines, office procedure, and data processing. The students develop competence in clerical office procedures including typing, filing, office practice, and calculating machines. Students are prepared to meet the standards of accuracy and speed required in business. In addition to these regular subjects, the student becomes familiar with vocabulary of the business field and technical work. The course also furnishes the student with a solid introduction of data processing equipment and computer practices.





GENERAL SHOP

During the ninth grade the students are assigned to several shops for career exploration. While working in the many shop areas, the student has an excellent opportunity to study the activities and skills required in the various occupations and to realize personal likes, dislikes and interest. Following this exploration/orientation the student, parents, teachers and guidance counselors mutually agree as to the skilled occupation to which the students will be assigned. Course assignments are the same for all ninth grade full-time students. The course of study consists of: Carpentry, Electricity, Metal-working, Drafting & Blueprint Reading. Each student in the 9th grade spends one cycle (10 wks) in each course of study.




