

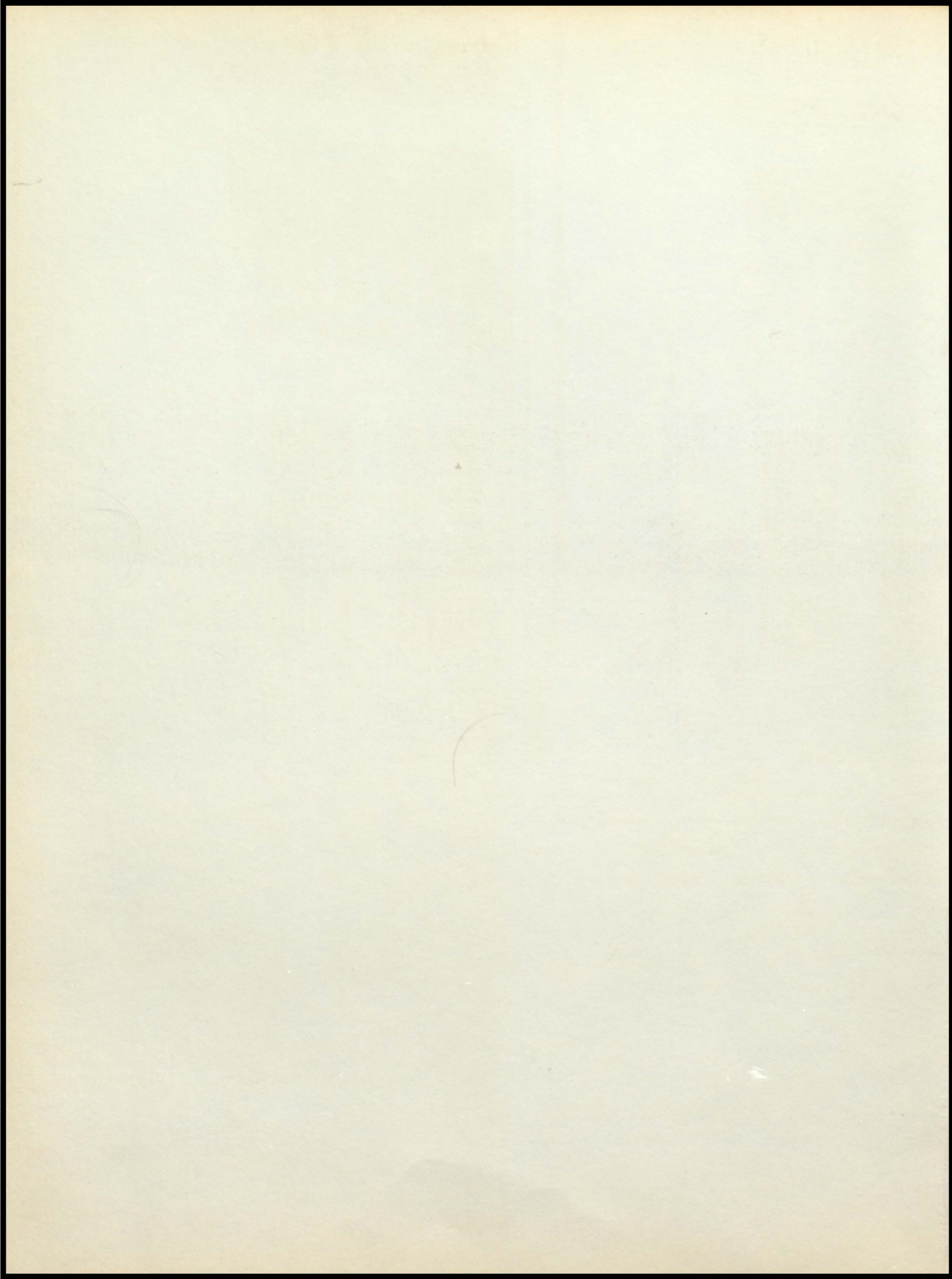



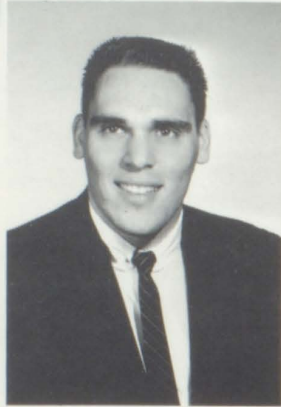

The Guidance Department helps the girls in whatever problems they may have. It is also responsible for registration, testing, and employment for qualified students.

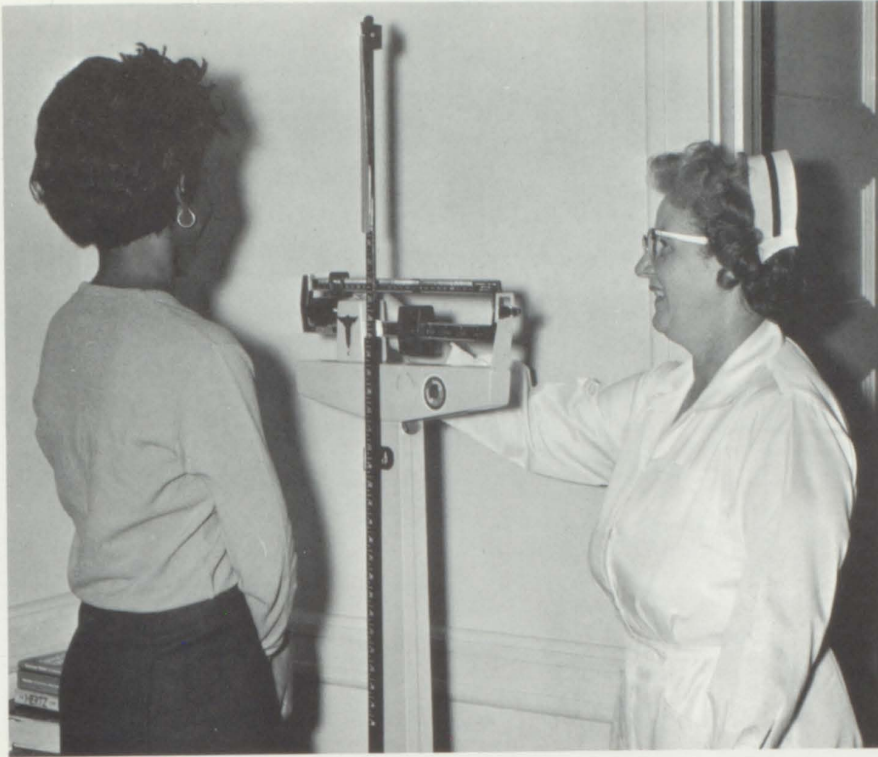

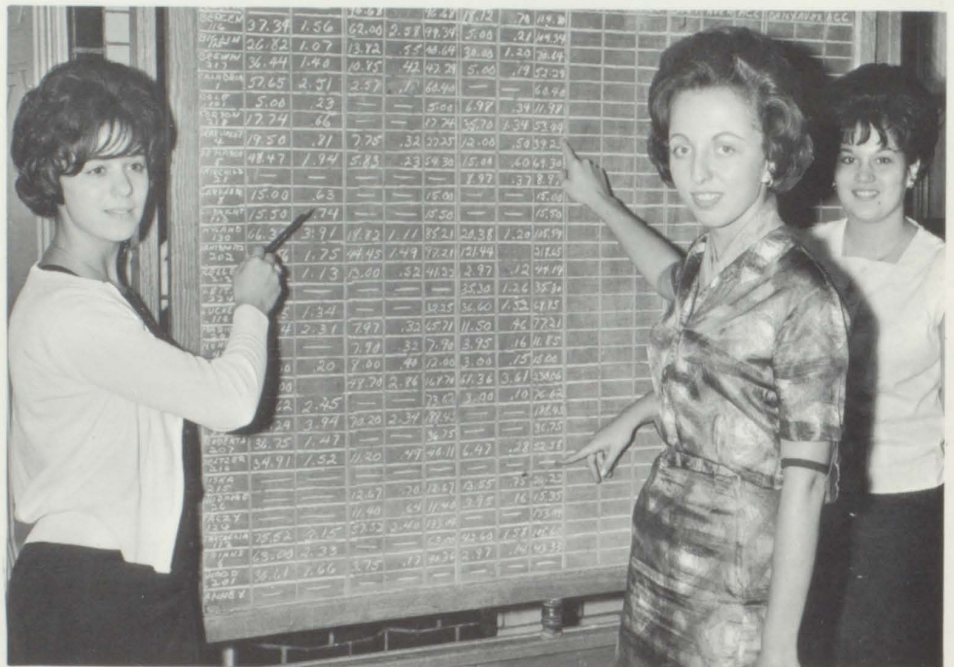

Competition is sharp, and the progress of the contest is followed on the board in the front hall.

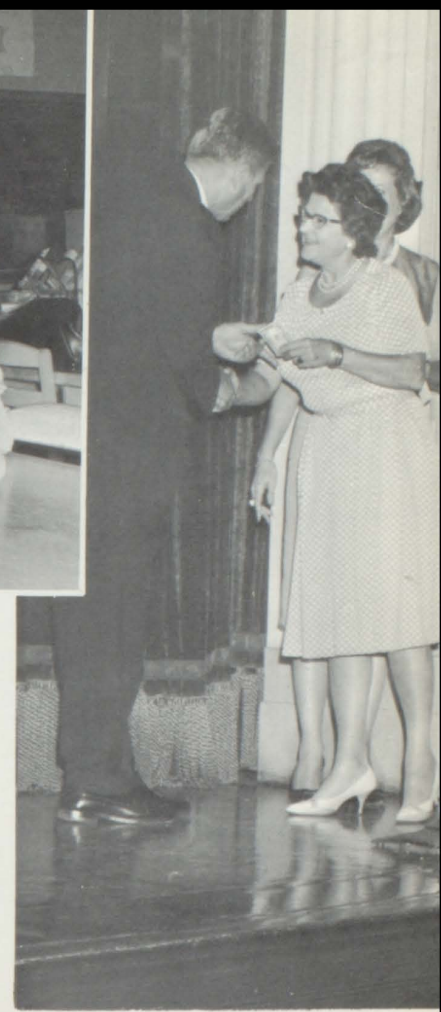
When it was all over, the total sales amounted to \$10,832.51!

JoAnn Suppa was third highest. She won the 8mm movie camera she wanted.

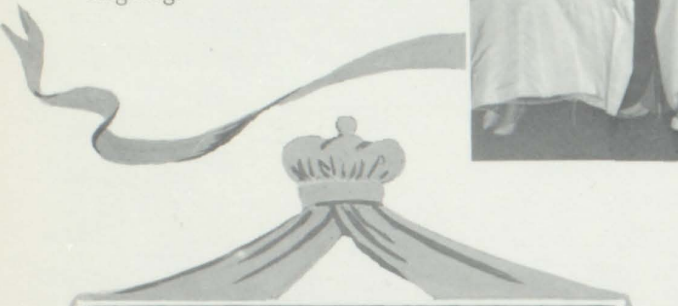


Cathy Fiaccavento came in fourth, and she, too, chose the luggage.

## Practical Nursing

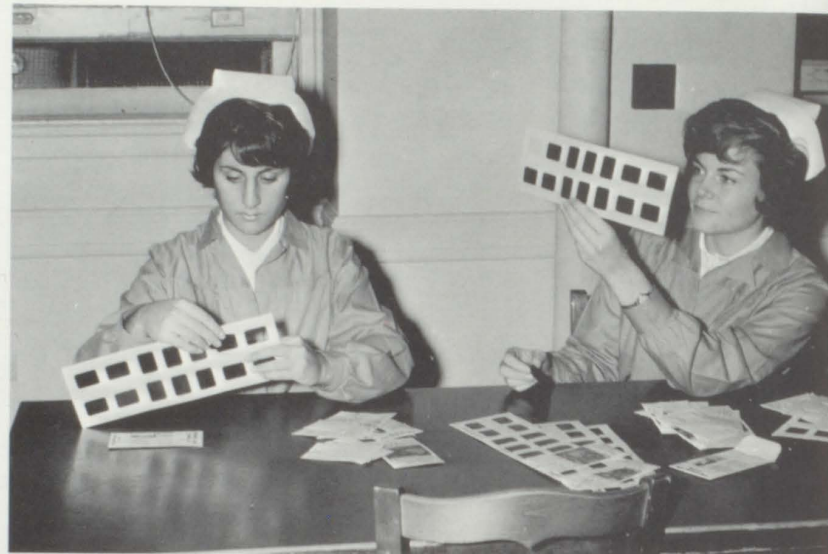
