Love for the charm and mystery of nature is shown by the Greeks in the richness and beauty of their mythology.

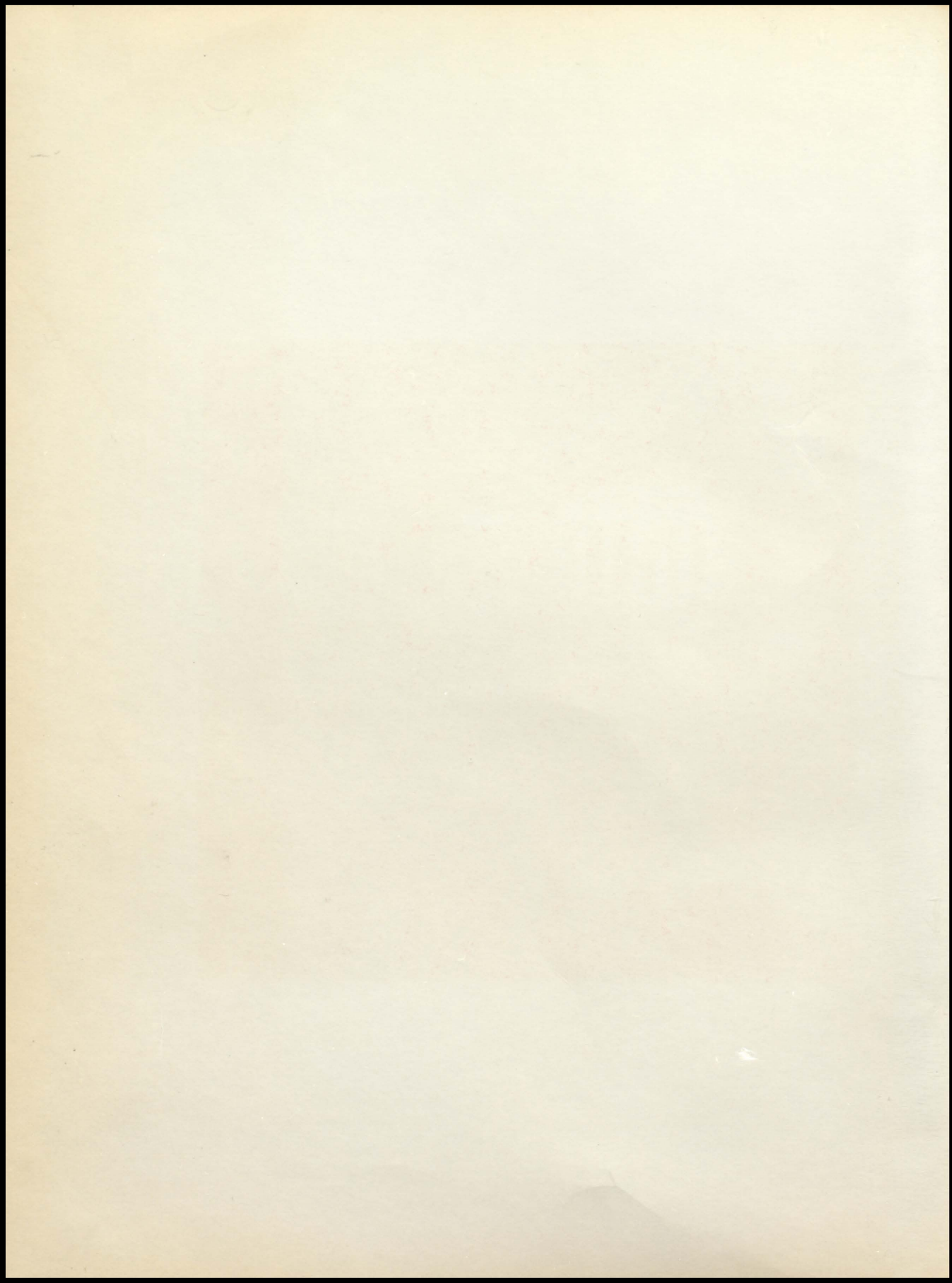
Shown is the religious center of ancient Athens, the Acropolis, dominated by the Parthenon, a tribute to Athena.

And most of all the gift of being kind;

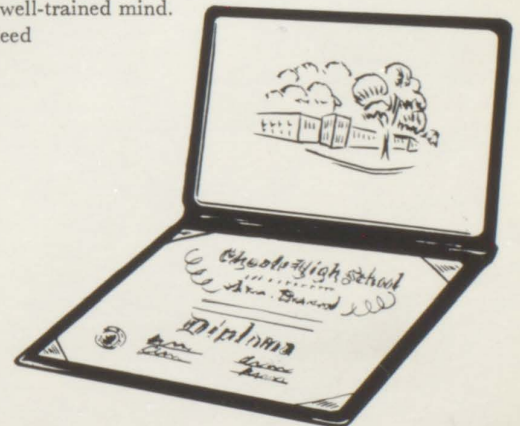
If you have learned that you must serve to master

Essex County is unique in its offerings of vocational and technical courses for young adults. Our school includes complete training in six different day courses that prepare young women for profitable and efficient employment.

Practical Nursing

This adult course is planned to meet license requirements in New Jersey. The student is introduced to the theory of nursing and practice in a modern medical arts department. She receives experience in medical and surgical nursing, and the care of mothers and infants, children, the mentally ill, chronic, aged, and convalescent patients.

An important phase of the course is the clinical experience provided in the clinics of one of our large hospitals.

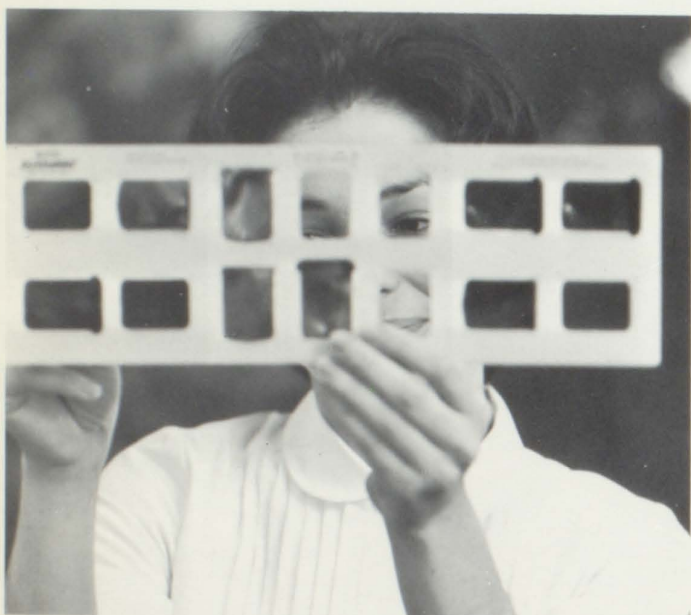

The student who takes this course is trained to assist the dentist in every way. An important part of the course is the time the student spends in dental clinics under the supervision of a trained dental assistant.

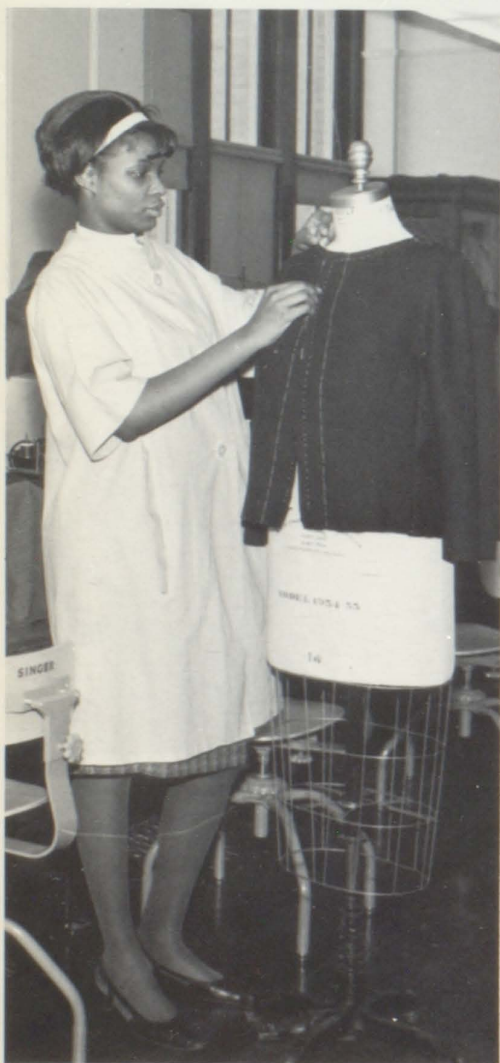

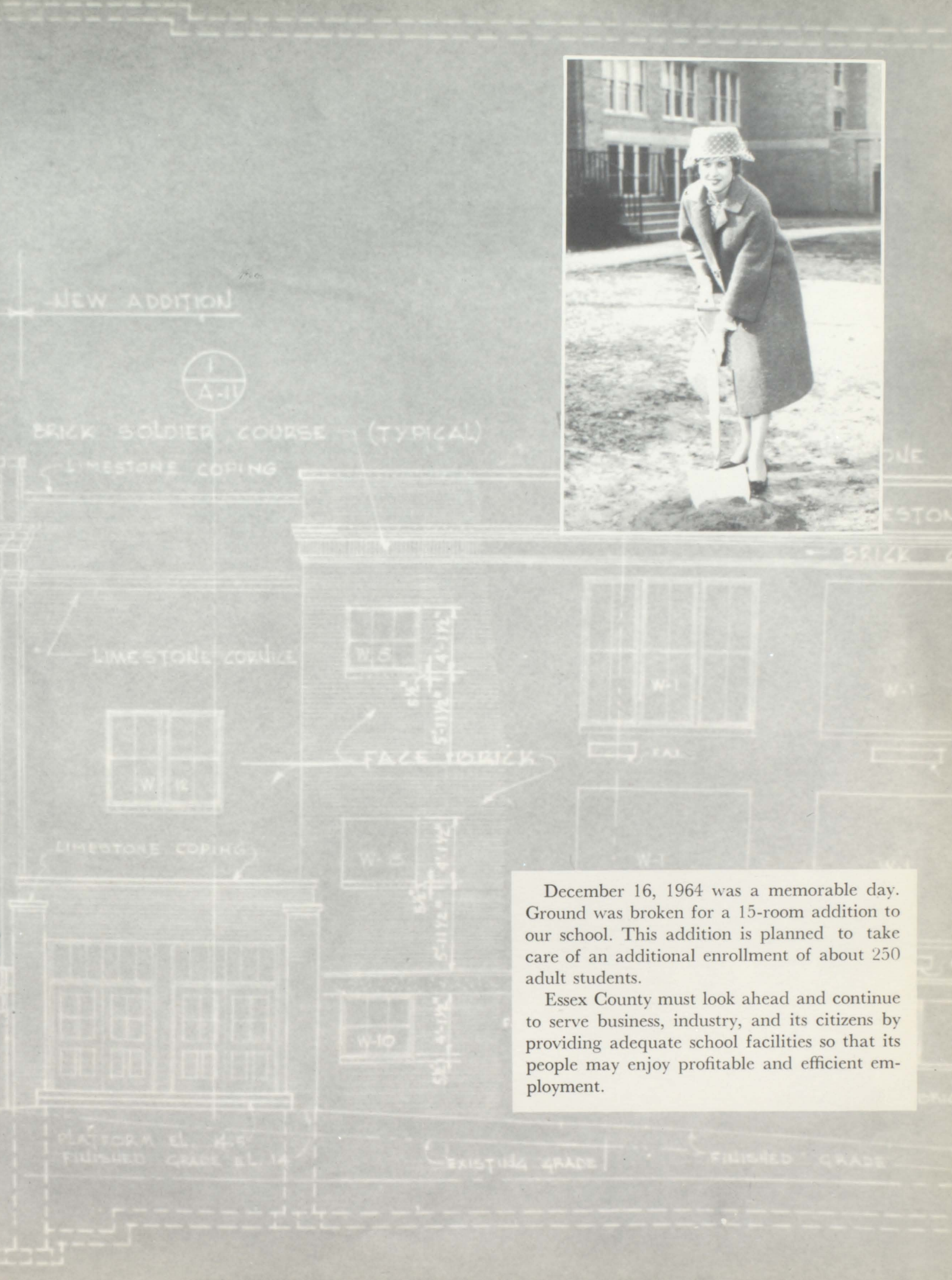
