The staff and I hope that we have helped to provide you with the skills, ideals, and attitudes that will help you to cope successfully with the future.

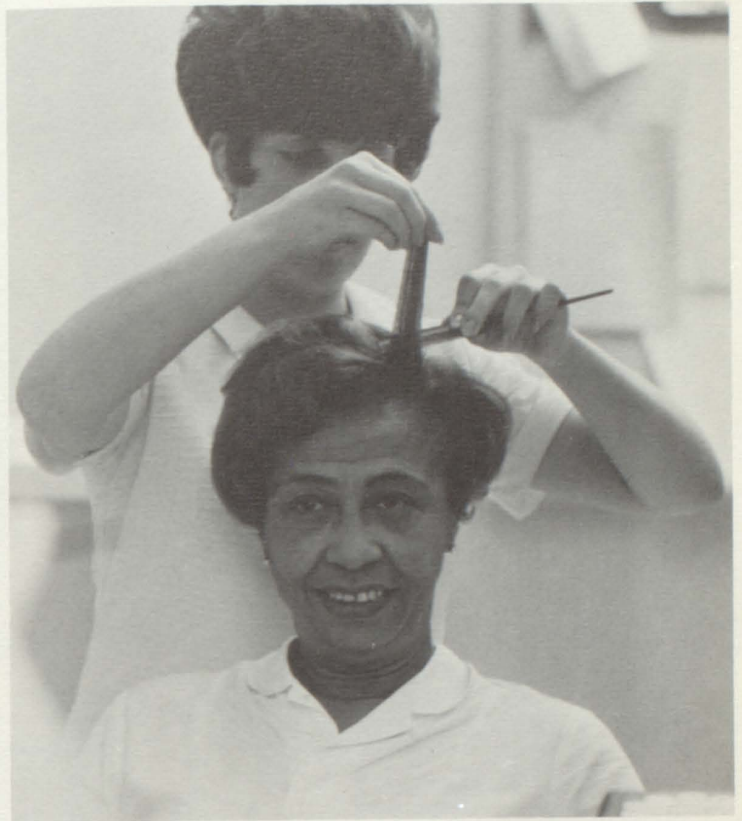

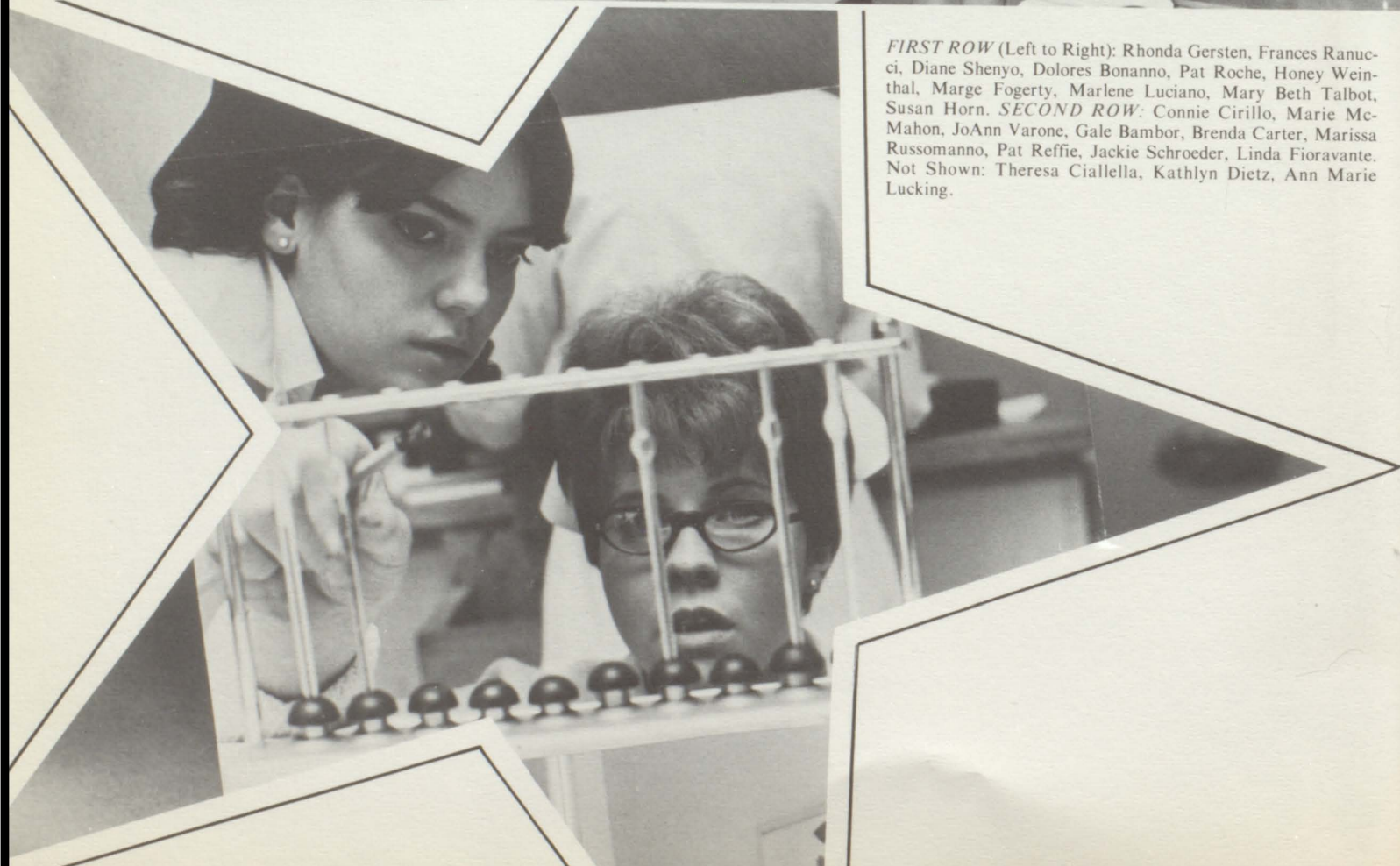


Medical Assistants
