## Parent Requests Application

$>$ Application with a completed essay is submitted to the first school requested.
$>$ Students take the Terra Nova assessment in Reading, Language and Mathematics.
$>$ School personnel review the Terra Nova scores, Application and essay.
> School personnel schedule an Interview
$>$ School Admission Committee reviews all student records including academic transcripts, progress reports, attendance records, standardized test scores, discipline records, IEP or current evaluation status/information, health records, etc.) of students being considered for admission.
> Information is rated as per the established rubric.
