Rumor has it there will be a new Galaxy Note called the 8 that will be launching in late March or April of 2017.

This new device will likely have highlights including a 4k screen, a cut edge Snapdragon chipset, 6GB of Ram, and a more efficient camera. Also, the Samsung Galaxy S8 will allegedly have an iris scanner of a foldable

5.1- and 5.5-inch sizes or 5.7 and 6.2-inch sizes.


