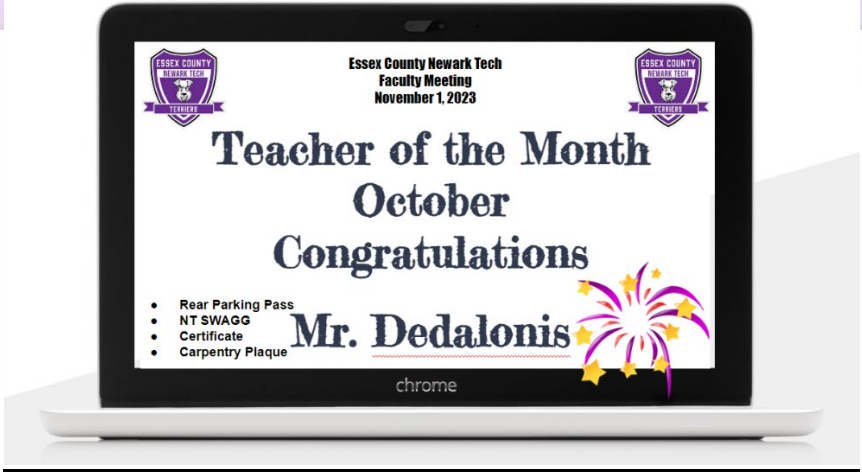
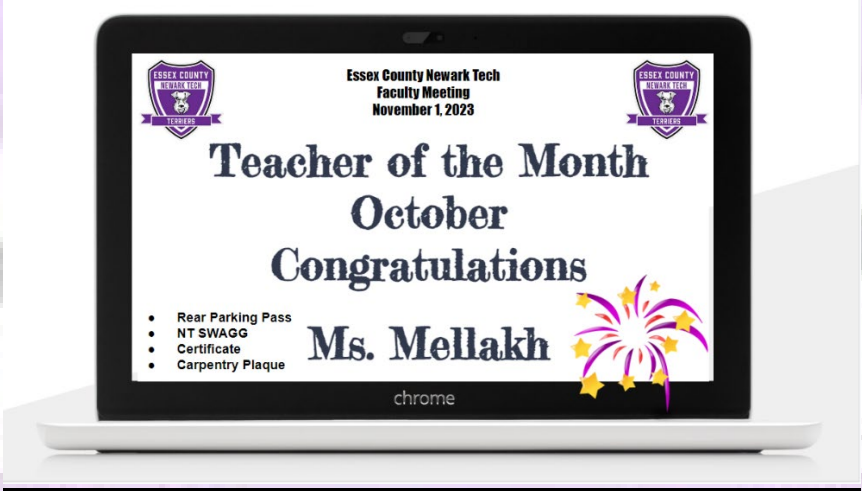

## Senior Sunrise

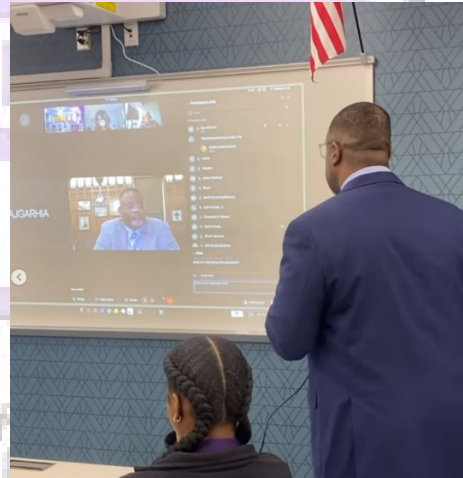

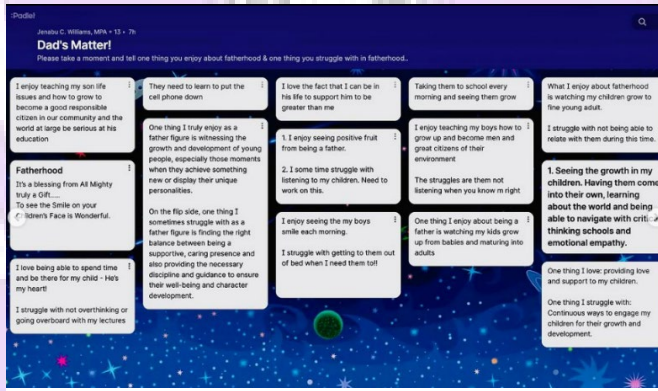
